



## FAQ'S

### What is a small group?

At Harvest, a small group is a tight-knit group of people intentionally seeking to live out the community of fellowship, study, provision, worship, and evangelism. For the most part, they meet weekly in homes and are led by trained volunteer members of the congregation.

### When are groups starting?

We are launching the new groups the first week of March! However, groups will always be available to join.

### How long will groups be meeting?

All of our groups will be long-term, meeting on a regular basis. Depending on what the groups study however, the discussion topics may have a definite start and end date. We will also have some classes starting soon that will meet for just a few months.

### How large will the small groups be?

An average number we will be shooting for is 8 to 12 people. If a group begins to expand larger than that, we will take steps to start a new group, using some members of the original.

### I'm not a member of Harvest. Is it ok if I join a group?

Absolutely! Everyone is welcome to take part in Christian community.

### Will I need to know a lot about the Bible for a small group?

No. The purpose of any Bible study done in the groups is to learn more about the Word as a community. What small groups are seeking is an atmosphere of honesty and openness, not a great knowledge of scripture.

### What will the groups be studying?

Most groups will be deciding the particular topic they study when they begin meeting together. If you are interested in a particular topic, make a note of that when you sign up to join a group, as we may be able to accommodate your preference.

### The group I signed up for isn't really a good fit for me. Is it ok if I try another group?

### Are people from all faith backgrounds welcome in your groups?

### Can I go to more than one group?

Absolutely. We would like to let you know that most people gain more by committing to a single group, rather than occasionally attending several different groups.
